1- VERSION

Même si cela ne fait que deux ans que Devangi Patel, âgée de 33 ans, travaille en tant qu'anesthésiste dans un grand centre médical aux abords d'Atlanta, son but est de pouvoir se permettre de quitter son emploi à 50 ans.

Le docteur Patel n'est pas seule dans sa quête de devenir financièrement indépendante et ce, à un âge relativement jeune. Il semble qu'un tournant générationnel est en cours : beaucoup de travailleurs jeunes ne souhaitent pas prendre leur retraite après 65 ans voire plus, comme leurs parents. À l'inverse, beaucoup de ces personnes ayant une carrière professionnelle cherchent à quitter leur emploi à 50 ans puis travailler pour eux-mêmes ou occuper un emploi moins bien rémunéré qui est plus aligné avec leurs intérêts.

Mais alors que beaucoup de travailleurs jeunes veulent être financièrement indépendants à la cinquantaine, ce n'est pas facilement atteignable car cela demandera sans doute de devoir épargner entre 50 et 60 pourcent de leur salaire. Ces personnes,

qui sont nés entre 1981 et 1996, ont commencé leurs vies professionnelles pendant la Grande Récession et naviguent dans un monde où les chemins traditionnels vers la richesse, tel que devenir propriétaire, sont loin d'être atteignables pour un plus grand pourcentage d'entre eux que ceux de la génération précédente.

Leurs attitudes sont aussi en train d'être formées en partie par l'incertitude : ils sont les témoins de tournants économiques majeurs, juste au moment où ils essaient de se construire une situation.

1. Should Charles III modernise the British monarchy?

According to W. Bagehot, the role of the British monarchy is 'to impress the many', meaning that its way of leading goes through keeping the population aware of the Royals superiority, and not just within its borders. But the monarchy has recently been weakened, and the Queen's death hasn't helped. || (50)

First of all, the monarchy should be modernised insofar as it is heavily criticized. Indeed, many British people consider that the Royals do insufficient work for the taxpayers' money they consume. On top of that, the institution is believed to be old-fashioned and maintains privileges of an ancient order. For that reason, Charles III should modernise the monarchy so that there would be less criticism leveled at it. || (67)

Another point is that the monarchy is struggling to get people's attention. For instance, Meghan

and Harry decided to air a TV series about them on Netflix, which is a very popular platform. They have understood how to get the public's attention, but not the Monarchy. Furthermore, a 2020 Yougov poll revealed that when she was alive, Queen Elizabeth was Britain's most admired woman. But now, with Charles being King, the situation is all the more concerning, since he was never really appreciated by British people ever since he cheated on Diana. || (89)

Considering what has been said, the monarchy definitely needs to be modernised and I believe that the best way for the monarchy to do so is through the media. As John Adams said 'The war of Independence was won in the hearts and minds of people with the help of newspapers and pamphlets which enlightened and informed public opinion'. It means that newspapers and media are very important to keep a relationship with the population. For instance, Queen Elizabeth I used to send portraits of herself during her reign - people could not meet her, but they could see her, and 'to be seen is to be believed'.
